This licence is issued subject to the provisions of the Environmental Protection and Management Act, the Environmental Protection and Management (Hazardous Substances) Regulations and to the following conditions:

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- 1 Hazardous substances in packaging such as drums, carboys etc are to be kept in a sheltered store with adequate security, ventilation and control facilities to contain spillage or leakage.
- 2 The licence holder shall ensure that all hazardous substances are transported in enclosed 20 footer containers or in goods vehicles which have enclosed cage or goods vehicles which have side-boards and tail-boards of height at least equal to the height of the hazardous substances stacked in the vehicles. The hazardous substances shall also be securely tied or attached to the vehicle to prevent movement during transportation.
- 3 Hazardous substances shall be labelled according to the Singapore Standard (Specification for hazard communication for hazardous chemicals and dangerous goods), SS 586-1:2021 and SS 586-2:2022.
- 4 The percentage and quantity refer to the maximum percentage and maximum aggregate storage quantity allowed for the hazardous substance; including preparations and solutions containing the hazardous substance.
- 5 For the import/export of hazardous substances controlled by NEA, you are to ensure that your company or your declaring agent declares the appropriate product codes when submitting the inward/outward permit applications. Misuse of the product code will render the licence holder/company liable to prosecution. The list of Product Codes can be found in NEA's web page at www.nea.gov.sg.
- 6 Licence/Permit holder shall immediately notify NEA upon occurrence of any incident involving the loss, releases and/or fires of hazardous substances.
- 7 Any information furnished for the purpose of obtaining this licence/permit is true and correct, and permission has been obtained from the owner(s) to use any proprietary information furnished.
- 8 If your premises meets the relevant criteria prescribed under the Fire Safety Act 1993, your company shall ensure that its Fire Certificate (FC) and documentation relating to the appointment of a Fire Safety Manager (FSM) and Company Emergency Response Team (CERT) are up to date.
- 9 Your company is required to submit information on chemical(s) that meet the reporting requirements under the Chemical Reporting Framework to the Chemical Control and Management Department prior to or during the renewal of this licence/permit. Please refer to the chemical reporting framework guidance document for more details about the reporting requirements.
- 10 The total quantity of hazardous substances stored at any one time shall not exceed 100MT unless approved containment facilities to contain contaminated fire-fighting water is being installed.
- 11 A safety audit report in conformance to PCD1's guideline on the Safety Audit Scheme on the Management of Hazardous Substances shall be submitted to PCD1 within 8 months of the licence start date and subsequently once every 2 years. The safety audit report shall be conducted by one of the safety audit firms listed in Annex 2 of the Safety Audit Guidelines in NEA's website and countersigned by an accredited lead auditor.
- 12 Where hazardous substances are stored in tanks, secondary containment facilities shall be provided to contain leakage, spillage or accidental discharge of the entire content of the largest storage tank.

This licence takes effect from 16 May 2026 and expires on 15 May 2031.
